





Call for applications Post-graduate Workshop Textometry of the historical sources

École française de Rome 2-6 June 2014

The École française de Rome and the Centre of Comparative Studies "I Deug-Su" of the University of Siena, in collaboration with the Laboratoire de Médiévistique Occidentale de Paris (UMR 8589 CNRS-Université Paris 1), organize in Rome from 2 to 6 June 2014 a workshop of *Textometry of the historical sources* for graduate students, that will be focussed on the application of the computing tools for textual analysis in historical and philological research. The workshop will present software such as PALM, Hyperbase, TXM, Stylometry, Lexicon and testing them on case studies. In the morning the teachers of the host institutions and guest specialists will illustrate a specific tool, and in the afternoon the young researchers will test that tool and present (In English, Italian or French) their work in progress, which will be discussed by the teachers and the other researchers.

The École Française de Rome offers offers 12 scholarships for junior researchers – doctoral and post doctoral students of History from across the European Union – including costs of accommodations and meals.

The best papers could be proposed for the publication by the Advisory Board to the Reading Commettee of the journal $M\'{e}langes$ de $l'\'{E}cole$ Française de Rome. Moyen $\^{A}ge$ (http://mefrm.revues.org/).
